

Last year, our total patron count was 12,129, but the number was inflated somewhat since old patron cards had not been regularly deleted from the system. We updated patron accounts this year, so our number is a little lower, but more accurate. Our percentage of active patrons increase a bit to 10.75%, last year it was 8.63%.

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Circulation Summary



Overview

When comparing this data to the previous year, we had increases in circulation to 5 of the 8 areas of our collection. We noticed quite an increase in audio resources: 20.9% last year, compared to 22.1% this year. The three areas with slight decrease were in Children's department: Easy, Juvenile, and Young Adult. Our goal is to continue to increase circulation in all areas of the collection.
