

Exhibits and Display Policy

Limited display space is available in the library for information about local area groups. Preference will first be given to library information and then to public exhibits that are timely and of general interest.

Public Displays: Displays that focus on a public issue (including elections and political issues) must include information about major aspects of differing points of view. Displays that are solely commercial in focus are not appropriate.

Displays will be changed in a timely manner. Groups or individuals desiring to display items in the library must have permission from the library Director. The library Director may reject any exhibit or display that does not fit with the mission of the library or that is not neat and legible.

The library will take reasonable care to ensure the safety and security of items displayed, however the library assumes no responsibility in the event of loss, theft, or damage. Display of items in the library does not indicate endorsement of the issues, events, or services promoted by those materials.

Library Displays: Library displays intended for a specific age group will only feature materials from corresponding collections. Displays in the Children's Department and Young Adult areas will consist of materials for children and teens. Displays with a possible age specific sensitivity will be limited to adult areas of the library. Displays with library information will be designated in all areas and for all ages.
