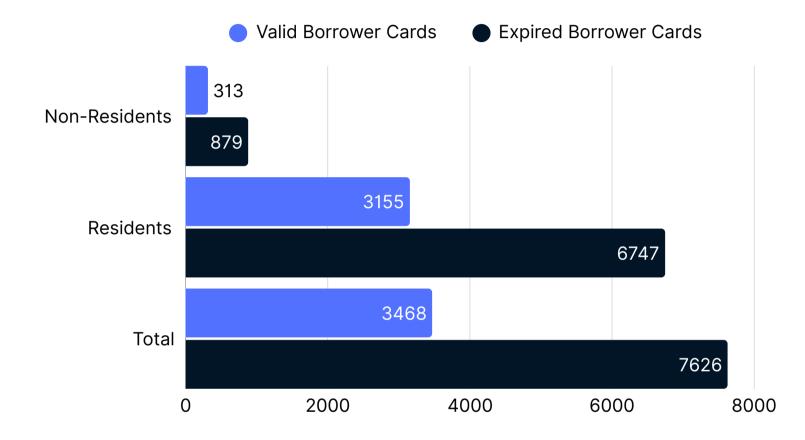

The legal service area of the library district is 20,022 (as of 2020).

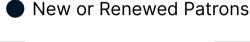


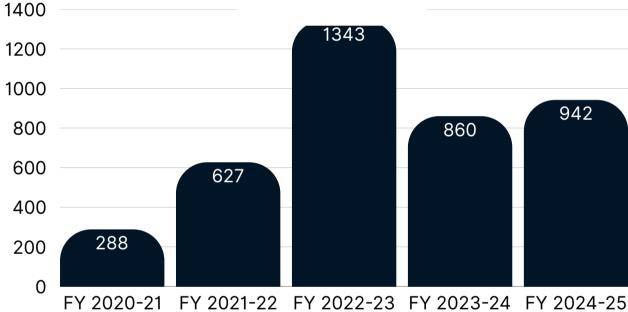
 Valid borrowers are patrons with a card that is not expired.

We have worked hard the last few years to increase our patron count since Covid. We are pleased to see so many patrons renewing their cards and new patrons coming in to get a library card.





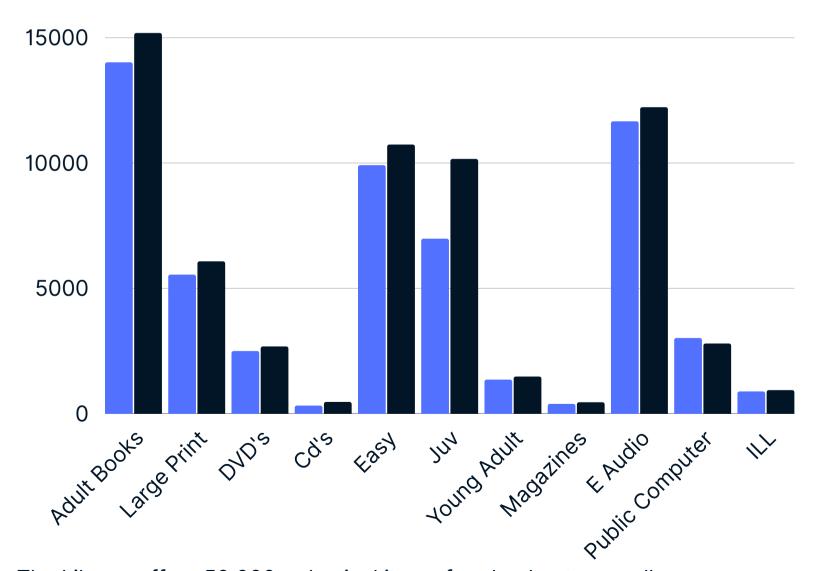
